

# Dr. Louis Lipschultz

Dr. Lipschultz was born in Chicago, and raised in Glenwood, he attended Brookwood Grade School, and Bloom High School in Chicago Heights. He then attended Eastern Illinois University majoring in chemical engineering and the pre-medicine track of coursework. He received his Doctor of Optometry degree in 1986 from the Illinois College of Optometry in Chicago.

After 14 years in private practice, Dr. Lipschultz left full-time practice in 2000 for Atlanta to assume the position of CEO of Pulse Data International, Inc. He coordinated a series of acquisitions which resulted in a new name: HumanWare. He left HumanWare in late 2003 to form several new companies focused on the vision impairment industry and accessible web application design.

Although his primary passion is working with visually impaired individuals, Dr. Lipschultz continues to allocate a significant portion of his patient care hours to general care, contact lens, and pediatric vision care. Dr. Lipschultz splits his time between his home in Southern California and his Olympia Fields office. While in California he manages his several technology companies, and enjoys time with his wife, Dr. Susan Cotter, a professor at the Marshall B. Ketchum University.
